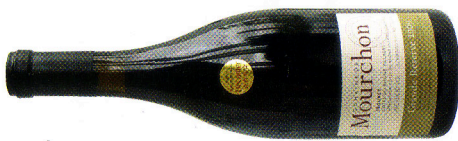
## Decanter - January 2011 Côtes du Rhône – Villages 2009

Chiselled cassis pastilles, spice, pine, smoke and dark fruit on the nose. Assertive palate with gorgeous fruit and ripe, chunky tannins. Complexity of spice and herb notes and a smooth finish. **Drink:** 2010-2012.

**Expert summary: John Livingston – Learmonth:**

“ My favourites in this tasting included wines from four poorly known villages. Séguret performed well. Its texture can be grainy, but winemaking has been improving for some time, led by the Scottish-owned Domaine de Mourchon. The result is gutsy wines, but ones seasoned with floral, herbal influences.”
