91 Domaine de Mourchon Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret **G Family Reserve 2007**
\$45 Very enticing, with blueberry, fig and boysenberry fruit laced with spice, fruitcake and melted licorice notes. The long, perfume- and graphite-filled finish is nicely rounded and plenty deep. Grenache. Drink now through 2011. – J.M.

91 Domaine de Mourchon Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret **Grande Réserve 2006**
\$24 Very dark, showing fig and currant plast notes, but very racy, with raphite, freshly drawn expresso, bittersweet cocoa and black tea notes helping to extend the long, alluring finish. Nice underlying grip. Drink now through 2011. – J.M.

90 Domaine de Mourchon Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret **S Family Reserve 2007**
\$40 Dark and broad, with crushed plum, hoisin sauce, black licorice snap and fruitcake notes backed by a fleshy, toasty finish. Racy and long, with lingering violet notes. Syrah. Drink now through 2011.– J.M.

88 Domaine de Mourchon Côtes du Rhône Villages Séguret **Tradition 2007**
\$16 Fresh, with floral, red currant and blackberry fruit notes backed by a tangy, mineral-tinged finish. Juicy and racy. Grenache, Syrah and Carignan. Drink now through 2010.– J.M.

87 Domaine de Mourchon **Côtes du Rhône 2008**
\$11 Fresh and juicy, with open-knit red cherry and currant fruit laced with hints of garrigue and tobacco. There's a nice chalky twinge on the finish. Drink now. – J.M.
