TASTING NOTES

A medium ruby wine with a harmonious nose of gentle spice and ripe red fruit. The palate is rich and elegant with a touch of oak. There is well-defined length with balanced freshness.

A wine to enjoy now with game served with cooked red fruit and a winter warming beef stew.

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| GRAPE VARIETIES | 70% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 10% Syrah |
| TERROIR | A mixture of parcels from "La Crau" with sandy soil, river stones, clay and limestone. |
| AGE OF VINES | 50 years |
| YIELD | 28hl/ha |
| WINEMAKING | Long maceration then ageing 70% in 600l oak containers and 30% concrete vats for 18 months |
| AGEING POTENTIAL | 5-10 years |
