TASTING NOTES

This wine has a ruby hue and a spicy bouquet of red and black fruits. It is medium-bodied and has the supple fruit, savoury and garrigue character that you would expect from the region. A versatile wine which goes well with charcuterie, grilled meats and pasta sauces.
