TASTING NOTES

Deep purple in colour with a complex nose of spicy fruit and savoury notes. Black figs and blackberries, coffee and bitter chocolate are all part of the harmonious expression of this sumptuous wine the length and depth of which are framed by grainy tannins and a focused freshness. Enjoy with roasted vegetables, red meat, wild game and creamy cheeses.

GRAPE VARIETIES	70% Grenache, 30% Syrah
TERROIR	This wine is made from vines planted on the three principal terroirs of Mourchon. We harvest the later-ripening fruit from the older vines for concentration from the low-yields.
AGE OF VINES	60 years
YIELD	20hl/ha
WINEMAKING	After a long maceration of 3 to 4 weeks, the Syrah is aged in oak barrels and the Grenache in wood and concrete vats for 18 months.
AGEING POTENTIAL	10-15 years
